

## Pool & Recreation Area Rules



### Two Creeks Crossing Resort



#### Access

- The pool and recreation areas are for registered guests and registered visitors only. No exception. People that purchase day passes and sign a waiver are considered registered guests. They will have access to lazy river, original pool area, recreation area and Swamper's.
- Wristbands issued upon check-in must be worn at all times to identify you as a registered guest. These wristbands also serve as your ticket to fun! They grant you access and use of the park's amenities, and facilities. You may be turned away from an amenity if a wristband is not present.
- No one under the age of 18 allowed in the jacuzzi without an adult.
- Wristbands are valid for a one-time use unless specified
- Wristbands are not replaceable if lost or damaged and are non-refundable.



#### Weather Closures

- For your safety, pools and amenities may close during severe weather, including lightning, heavy rain, or high winds.
- In the event of a closure, guests will be asked to exit the water and surrounding areas, including pool decks and cabanas, and remove personal belongings.
- We will reopen as soon as it is safe to do so.



#### Hours of Operation – See Seasonal Schedule

- Pool hours: 10 AM – 9 PM Year round – Registered Guests Only
- Lazy River: 10 AM – 9 PM Fridays & Saturdays Opened during Peak-Season
- Lazy River: 10 AM – 6 PM Sunday, Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday & Thursday.



#### Day Pass Rules

- Check-In Required: All guests must check in at the front desk upon arrival.
- Wristbands: Wristbands must be worn at all times while on property.
- Conduct: Respectful behavior is expected. Resort staff reserve the right to remove guests for violations.



#### Food & Beverage Policy

- Outside food, drinks, and coolers are not permitted in the pool or lazy river areas. Food can be eaten at our pavilion, the food trucks or Swampers Icehouse areas.
- Bags are subject to search due to TABC and insurance requirements.
- Empty personal cups may be brought in.
- No glass containers are allowed.
- Food is not allowed in any pool or the lazy river.
- A variety of food and beverages, including adult and kid-friendly options, are available for purchase on-site.
- The grills in the pool area will not be available for use during peak season.

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#### Safety & Health

- All bags and personal items are subject to inspection.
- U.S. Coast Guard-approved life jackets and puddle jumpers are encouraged for children 48 inches or under.
- Swim diapers are required for all infants and toddlers who are not potty trained.
- Guests who have a communicable illness, or who have experienced diarrhea or vomiting within the past 3 days, should not use the pools.



#### Swim Attire

- Proper swimwear is required and must be appropriate for a family-friendly environment.
- Prohibited attire includes:
  - Jeans, cut-offs, or undergarments
  - Revealing swimwear
  - Clothing with offensive language or graphics (violence, nudity, vulgarity, or discrimination)
- Swimwear with exposed metal (buckles, rivets, zippers) or sharp objects is not allowed.



#### Supervision & Lifeguards

- No lifeguard on duty — swim at your own risk.
- Children 16 and under must be accompanied and directly supervised by an adult at all times.



#### Conduct & Restrictions

- Smoking, vaping, and e-cigarettes are not permitted in or around pool areas.
- Large flotation devices (rafts, oversized floats) are not allowed.
- Personal music or sound devices are prohibited. Music is provided by the resort.
- Pets are not allowed, with the exception of service animals. Service animals must always remain with their handler and are not permitted in the water.
- Excessive drinking of alcoholic beverages, drunkenness, and public intoxication is prohibited and will be grounds for immediate removal from the pool area.
- Abusive or inappropriate language, clothing, or behavior will NOT be permitted.
- Diving into the pool, lazy river is prohibited
- Running on the pool deck is prohibited
- Excessive splashing of other guests or splashing in the pool swim-up bar is prohibited.

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#### Prohibited Items

- Firearms, ammunition, knives, or weapons of any kind are strictly prohibited.



#### Liability & Enforcement

- Failure to comply may result in removal from the property without a refund.
- Guests are responsible for their own safety and the safety and behavior of those in their care.
- You are ultimately responsible for you and your child's safety and conduct. By entering the property, you assume all risks associated with the activities on the property.
- Entry onto the property constitutes acceptance of all risks associated with resort activities.
- Day Pass Guest need to sign off on Resort/Pool Rules.
- By entering Two Creeks Crossing Resort patrons are responsible for reading and obeying all posted and oral rules and warnings. Failure to do so will be grounds for reservation and/or day pass to be canceled and removal from Two Creeks Crossing Resort property without a refund.
- **MANAGEMENT RESERVES THE RIGHT TO DENY USE OF THE POOLS TO ANYONE AT ANYTIME.**



#### Warning

- **TEXAS LAW (CHAPTER 75D, CIVIL PRACTICE AND REMEDIES CODE) LIMITS THE LIABILITY OF THE OWNER OR OPERATOR OF A WATER PARK ENTITY FOR INJURIES OR DEATH OF A WATER PARK PARTICIPANT RESULTING FROM ATTENDANCE AT A WATER PARK OR PARTICIPATION IN A WATER PARK ACTIVITY.**

#### Guest Acknowledgment

- By signing below, I acknowledge that I have received, read, understand, and agree to comply with all Pool & Recreation Area Rules for Two Creeks Crossing Resort, including all posted rules, oral instructions, safety warnings, and staff directions. **No lifeguard on duty.**
- I understand that use of the pool, lazy river, jacuzzi, recreation areas, decks, cabanas, walkways, food and beverage areas, and related amenities involves inherent risks, including but not limited to slips, trips, falls, drowning, near-drowning, collisions, weather-related hazards, illness, injury, property damage, and death.



#### Assumption of Risk

- I voluntarily choose to enter and participate in activities at Two Creeks Crossing Resort and Blue Bayou Bend. I knowingly and freely assume all risks, known and unknown, associated with my attendance, entry, participation, and use of the property and amenities.



#### Release of Liability

TO THE FULLEST EXTENT PERMITTED BY TEXAS LAW, I RELEASE, WAIVE, AND DISCHARGE TWO CREEKS CROSSING RESORT, BLUE BAYOU BEND, THEIR OWNERS, OPERATORS, OFFICERS, EMPLOYEES, AGENTS, REPRESENTATIVES, CONTRACTORS, AFFILIATES, SUCCESSORS, AND ASSIGNS FROM ANY AND ALL CLAIMS, DEMANDS, DAMAGES, LOSSES, LIABILITY, CAUSES OF ACTION, OR EXPENSES ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO MY ENTRY, ATTENDANCE, PARTICIPATION, OR USE OF THE PROPERTY, INCLUDING CLAIMS ARISING FROM THE ORDINARY NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASED PARTIES.



#### Indemnity, Minors & Medical Authorization

- I agree to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the released parties from any claims, damages, losses, costs, attorney's fees, or expenses arising out of my actions, my failure to follow rules or instructions, my violation of any policy, or the actions of any minor or guest for whom I am responsible.
- If I am signing on behalf of a minor child, I represent that I am the parent or legal guardian of the minor or have legal authority to sign on the minor's behalf. I accept full responsibility for supervising the minor at all times and agree that the minor must follow all Pool & Recreation Area Rules.
- I certify that I and any minors or guests under my supervision are physically able to participate and do not have a communicable illness or symptoms that would make pool use unsafe or prohibited under the rules.
- In the event of an emergency, I authorize Two Creeks Crossing Resort staff to seek emergency medical assistance. I understand that I am responsible for any medical costs incurred.
- I understand that failure to comply with the Pool & Recreation Area Rules may result in removal from the property without refund. I understand that management reserves the right to deny use of the pools to anyone at anytime.
